**Items 1 & 2** Mrs. Garza called the meeting to order at 7:00 p.m., after noting a quorum was present and that the meeting notice had been posted as required by law.

**Item 3** ROTC Color Guard led in the Pledge of Allegiance.

**Item 4** Welcome/Open Forum:

Mrs. Garza welcomed everyone and invited comments from the audience.

Carolyn Dawson, Third Grade Teacher, spoke on the reasons why she supports the restructuring of the Elementary and Intermediate campuses.

Parent Mirna Garcia addressed concerns that she has heard regarding the restructuring of the campuses and said that she believes restructuring will benefit the students.
